

### 2026 K-12 and Higher Education Lighting Market Driver Initiative

This offering begins on March 30, 2026, and is applicable to projects that implement prescriptive measure LT302 - Lumens per Watt Improvement (Mean Efficacy Increase  $\geq$  5%) utilizing hours of operation at qualified K-12 and Higher Education Consumers Energy electric customer sites. The offering will raise the total incentive to \$0.17 gross kWh saved. The total project incentive cannot exceed the total project cost. The approved electric incentive amount will be paid to the payee, based on the approved final application for the project. Only new Pre Applications for the 2026 program year submitted on or after March 30, 2026 are eligible for this bonus. Any project for which an application was previously submitted, and the project was subsequently cancelled in the Consumers Energy Business Energy Efficiency Program incentive project tracking system, even if an application is re-submitted on or after March 30, 2026, is not eligible for this bonus offer. Final applications and all remaining project documentation must be submitted by the Trade Ally or Customer by the applicable offering deadline of November 30, 2026. Applications are subject to inspection including but not limited to light logging to verify hours of operation. The offering pool is limited, and the offering will end once the offering pool has been allocated. Applications will not be eligible for any additional market driver initiative or offering.

Pre Application after March 30, 2026 AND Final Applications received by November 30, 2026
Total Offering Pool = \$750,000

#### Eligibility

- This offering is paid with the measure incentive to the Application Payee unless otherwise requested.
- If payee is a Trade Ally the Trade Ally must be in good standing to receive the increased incentive.
- Pre application is required and must be submitted and reserved prior to installation starting.
- Final application is required and must be submitted after installation is complete.
- The total project incentive will not exceed the full project cost.
