Trade Ally Program Enrollment Checklist



Enrollment as a trade ally on our new portal will be easier than ever. Please gather the following items prior to registering:

- √ **Completed W-9**
- √ **Certificate of Insurance***
- √ **PA Home Improvement Contractor Number (PAHIC#)**
- √ **Satisfactory Dun and Bradstreet Rating (DUNS ID)**

OR

At least two of the following references, providing reference name, email, phone number and address:

- Banking reference
- Three professional/trade references
- Principles of company with satisfactory credit score and no outstanding liens / judgement

- √ **BPI Building Analyst Certificate** if applying to be an in-home audit trade ally
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*Certificate of insurance(s) must list CLEAResult and PPL Electric Utilities as additional insured with the following types of insurance at the following minimal levels of coverage:

- **Commercial General Liability** covering bodily injury and property damage, minimum \$1,000,000 aggregate and per occurrence
- **Automotive Liability** covering owned, non-owned and hired vehicles, minimum \$1,000,000 combined single limit
- **Workers' Compensation** in accordance with statutory minimums but including no less than Employer's Liability minimum \$500,000 aggregate and \$100,000 per occurrence and per employee
